Also in attendance was County Attorney Tom Edwards and Sheriff Robert Fisk. Judge Meador called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.

#### No. 350

Judge Meador stated that an ad had been in the paper three times for the Deputy Clerk position and he had three resumes received. They were from D'anna Russell, Nicole Proctor-McCleskey and Sabrina Deam. The court took their time to review each resume. After reviewing the resumes, the court went into Executive Session at 9:45am to discuss the resumes.

Court went back into Open Session at 9:54am.

Commissioner Jameson made the motion to hire D'anna Russell. Commissioner Campbell seconded the motion and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

### No. 351

The next item on the agenda was to set the salary for the Deputy Clerk position. Judge Meador made the suggestion to base the salary off of \$18,720 for the next three months and stated that a budget amendment would be required. Commissioner Campbell asked Clerk Aldrich when her last day was going to be and she stated that they will be moving May 27<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Jameson made the statement that he would expect someone here full-time to keep the office open. Commissioner Brooks made the motion to set the salary at \$18,720 per year. Commissioner Cruse seconded the motion and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

There was no further business to discuss. Commissioner Campbell made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Brooks seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote and court adjourned at 10:02 am
