BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the 13th day of December 2021, the Commissioners' Court of Motley County met in Regular Session in the Courthouse in Matador, Texas. Called to order at 9:01 am by Judge Meador, Invocation was given by Commissioner Campbell and the following members present:

No. 393

Clerk Russell read the minutes from the Special Sessions held on November 5th and Commissioner Cruse made the motion to accept the minutes as read, seconded by Commissioner Campbell and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote, Minutes from the regular session of Commissioners Court were read and motion by Commissioner Campbell to accept the minutes as read, seconded by Commissioner Brooks and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote. The last minutes were read from the Special Session held on November 12th, and after a mark through and initialed correction removing Commissioner Brooks from the attendance of that meeting the motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Cruse to accept the minutes and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote Commissioner Campbell made the motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Brooks. The motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

Commissioner Jameson made the motion to approve the monthly reports for the District and County Clerk, Extension Agent, Justice of the Peace, Library, and the Tax Assessor-Collector. Commissioner Campbell seconded the motion and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

The outstanding bills were presented by County Treasurer Jones, and reviewed by the commissioners. Motion by Commissioner Campbell approve the bills, Commissioner Brooks seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

Judge Meador ask the court to consider the option of taking Commissioners Training Online as long as it isn't a Commissioners' first years in office. (First year by Statue is mandatory in person). After discussion about contacts you make going to trainings in person and various other positives about attending in person training the motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Cruse to do online as long as the commissioner met the requirements. Motion carried with a 5 to 0 vote.

Judge Meador asked the court to consider adopting a Burn Ban for the County considering how dry it is. After discussing the pros out weighed the cons and the Motion was made by Commissioner Cruse and seconded by Commissioner Campbell to put a Burn Ban in effect. Motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote. Each commissioner is responsible for putting the signs up in their precincts and it will also be put in the paper, on the county website and placed on the courthouse door.

There being no other business court adjourned at 10:30 a.m. on the motion of Commissioner Jameson and seconded by Commissioner Cruse and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.
